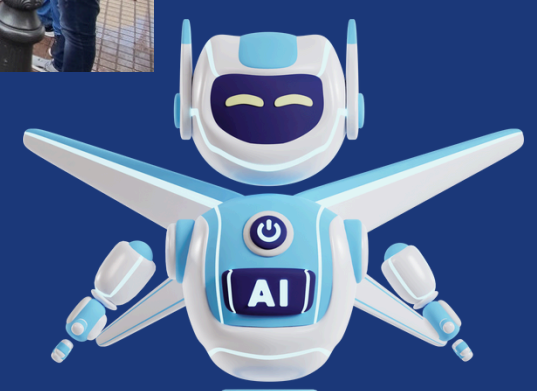

Víctor Guerra (Telecommunications Engineer, 2010; Master's in Intelligent Systems, 2012; PhD in Cybernetics and Telecommunications, 2016) is a researcher with extensive experience in European research projects, having participated in six international initiatives. He is currently the technical leader of the OCC4SAT project, which explores intra-satellite wireless connectivity using cameras and LED devices, with the goal of reducing the complexity of satellite cabling.

For over a decade, he has been focused on the use of artificial intelligence to optimize wireless communications, addressing challenges such as efficient access, performance, and resource use in networks. He has also applied generative artificial intelligence (GenAI) in education, designing solutions to personalize the learning experience and improve student motivation and engagement.



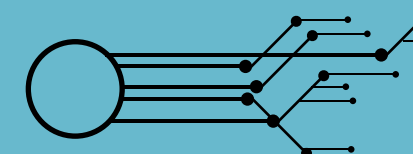
## Fernando Trujillo Sáez

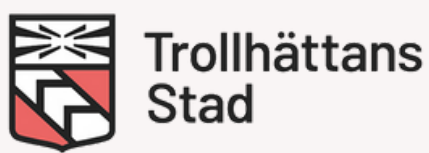

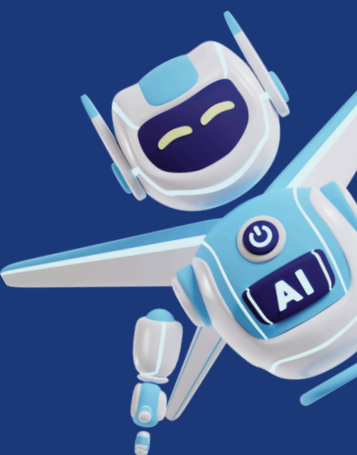
